Raffle Rules - North Coast Men's Chorus - Mardi Gras 50/50 Raffle

6. Prize Drawing

On February 4, 2017, the Sponsor (NCMC) will select the winner in a random drawing from among all eligible entries received. The odds of being selected depend on the number of entries received. If the winner is not present at the time of the drawing, the Sponsor will attempt to notify the potential winner via telephone or

email on or about February 7, 2017. If the potential winner cannot be contacted within five (5) days after the date of the first attempt to contact him/her, the Sponsor may select an alternate potential winner in his/her place at random from the remaining non-winning, eligible entries.

7. Prizes

Winner will receive a cash prize value at one half (1/2) the total raffle sales.

8. General Conditions

The Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Raffle or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner.
